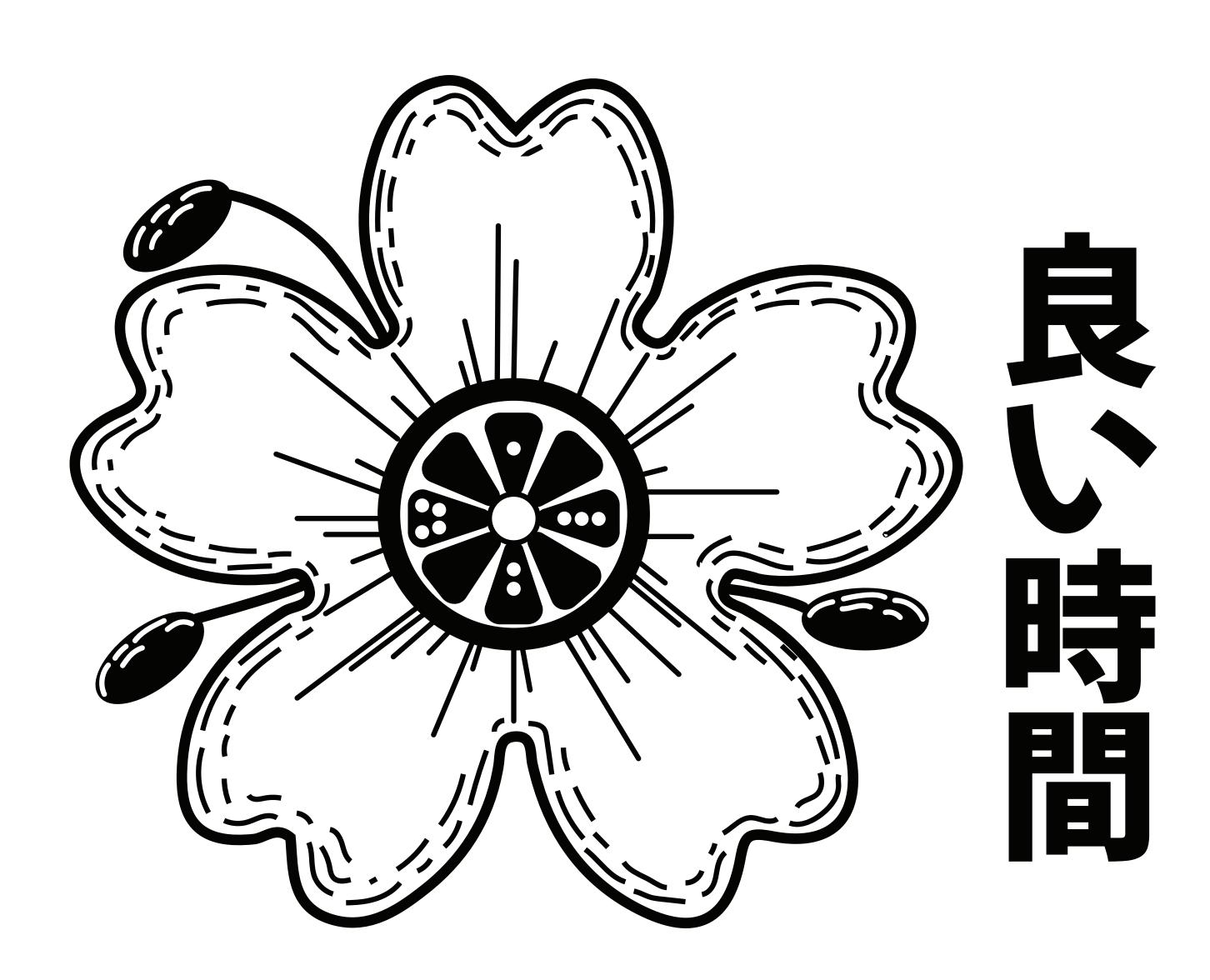

The flower represents the game Hanafuda, and the center represents a dice and a lemon slice for my favorite drink.



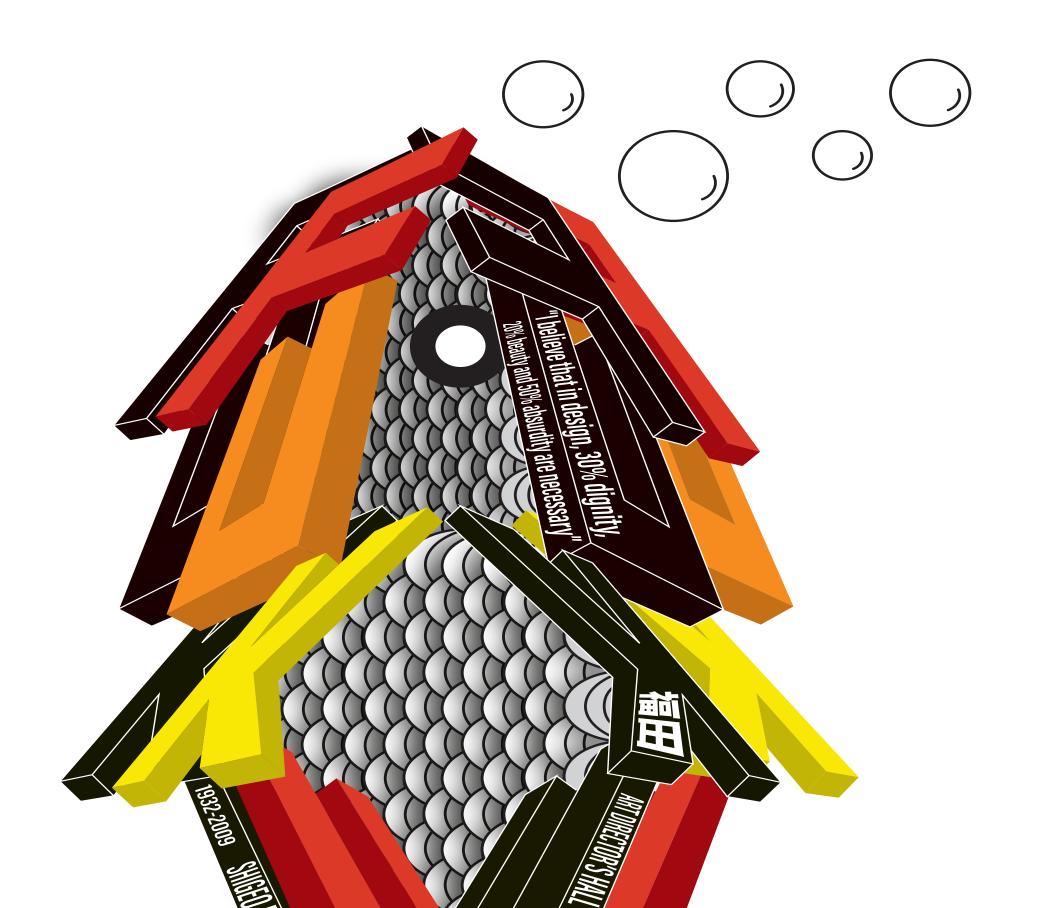




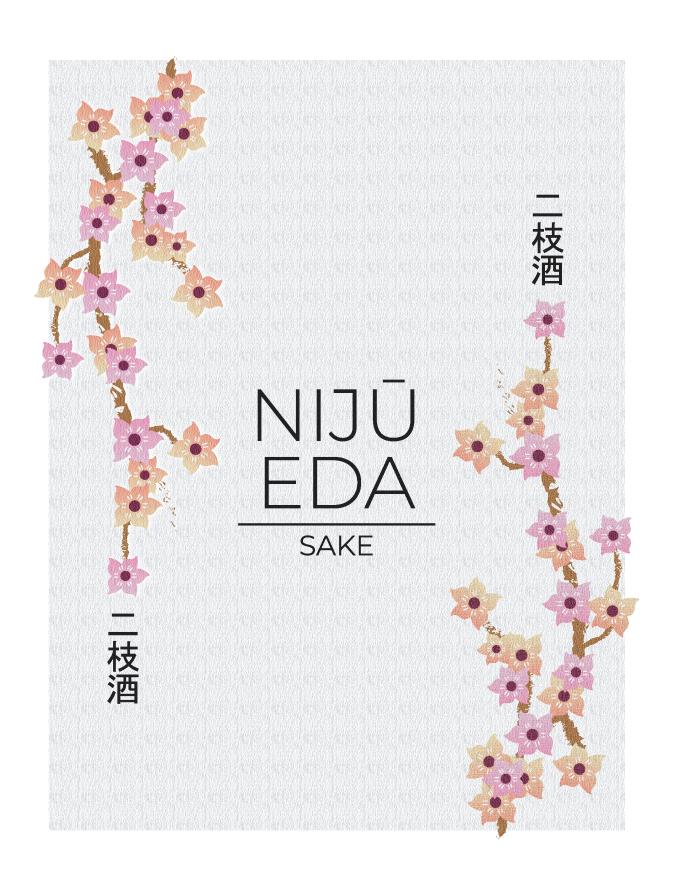
Create a poster that represents a chosen graphic designer, and then make a poster in their style as a tribute to them.

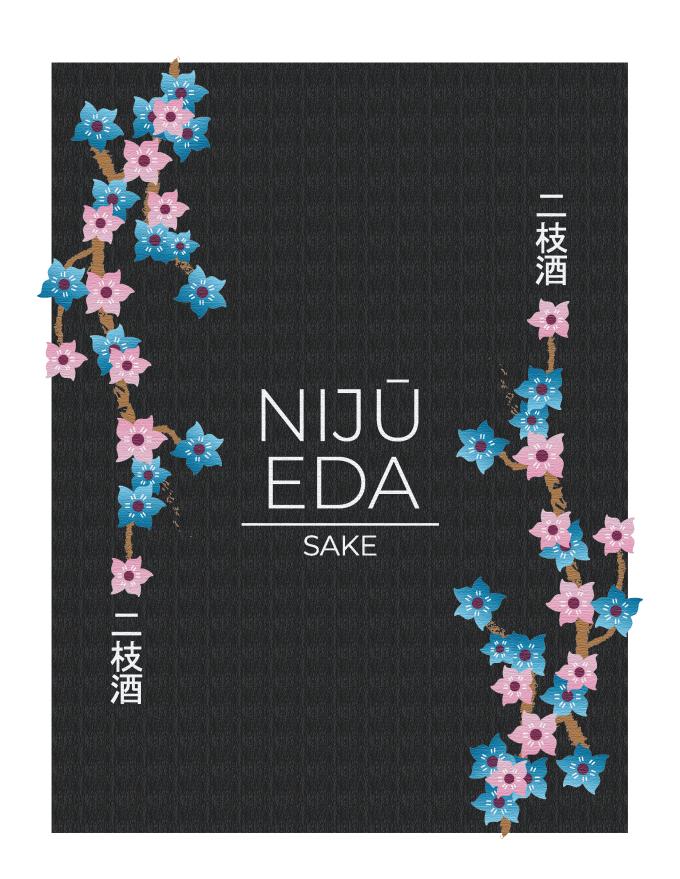
THE SOLUTION:

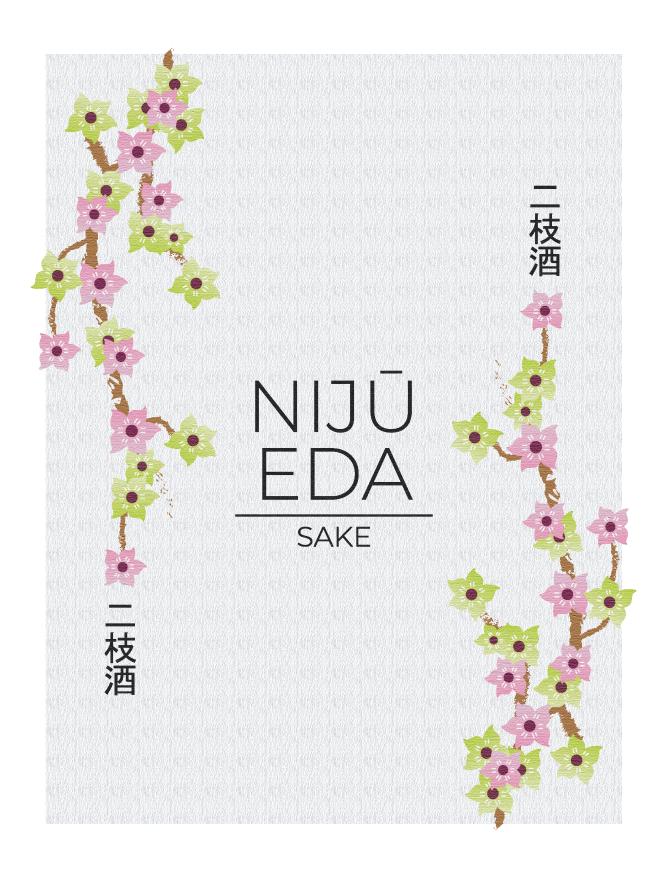

My poster is Fukuda's name that makes the shape of a fish. I made every letter individually in Illustrator, then used the perspective tool to shape and distort them.

images of symbolism.





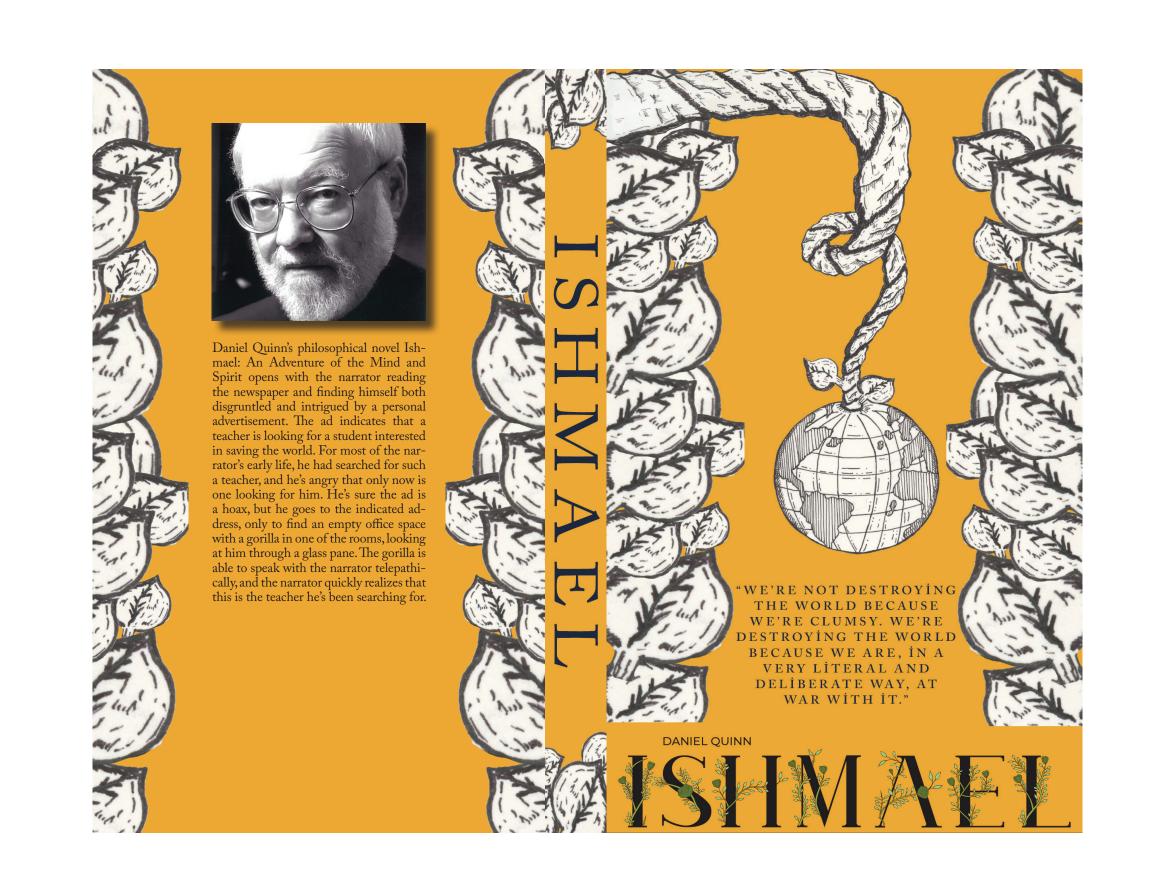


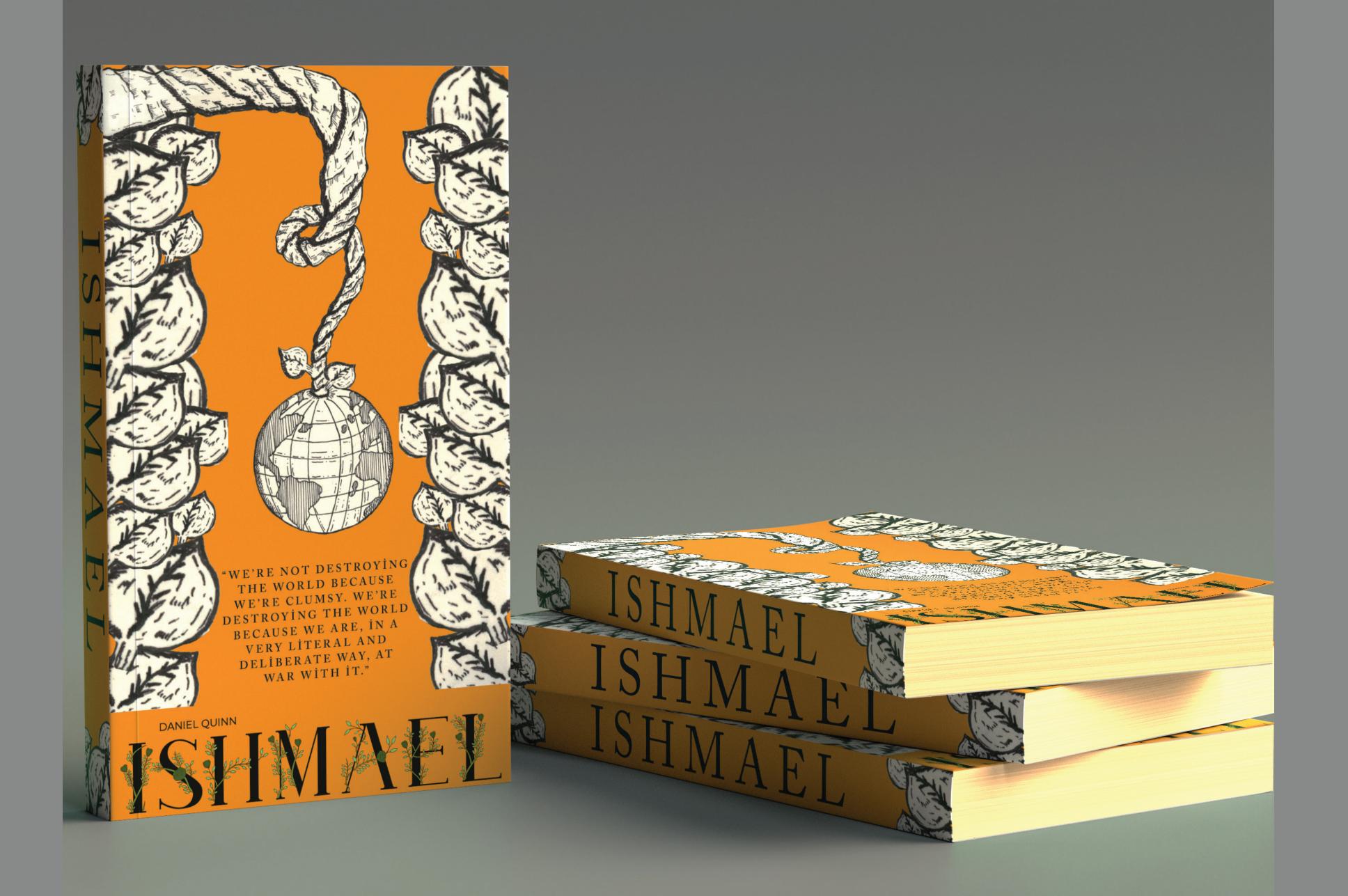


Create a book cover design that helps represent the contents of the book. The cover should be attractive to the eye, and contain symbolism that represents the aspects of the book

I made a grunge-like magazine that showcases him and his art work. It is typed out in Japanese, and showcases some of his famous artwork.











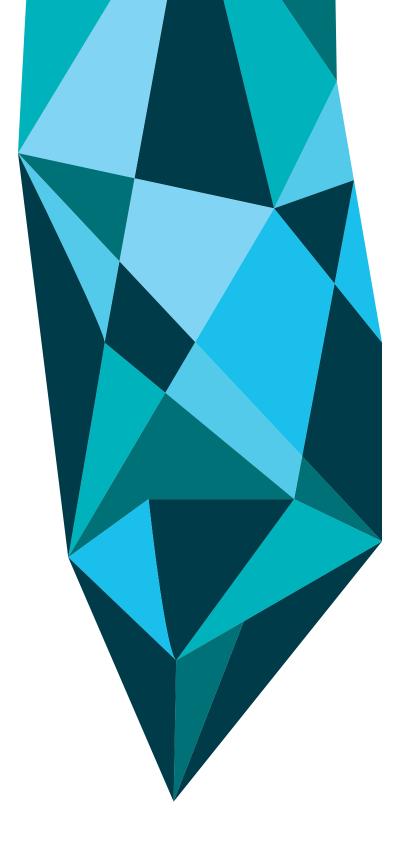


The goal was to create a sheet of stickers that represented a business. The business I went with was a rock/crystal shop.

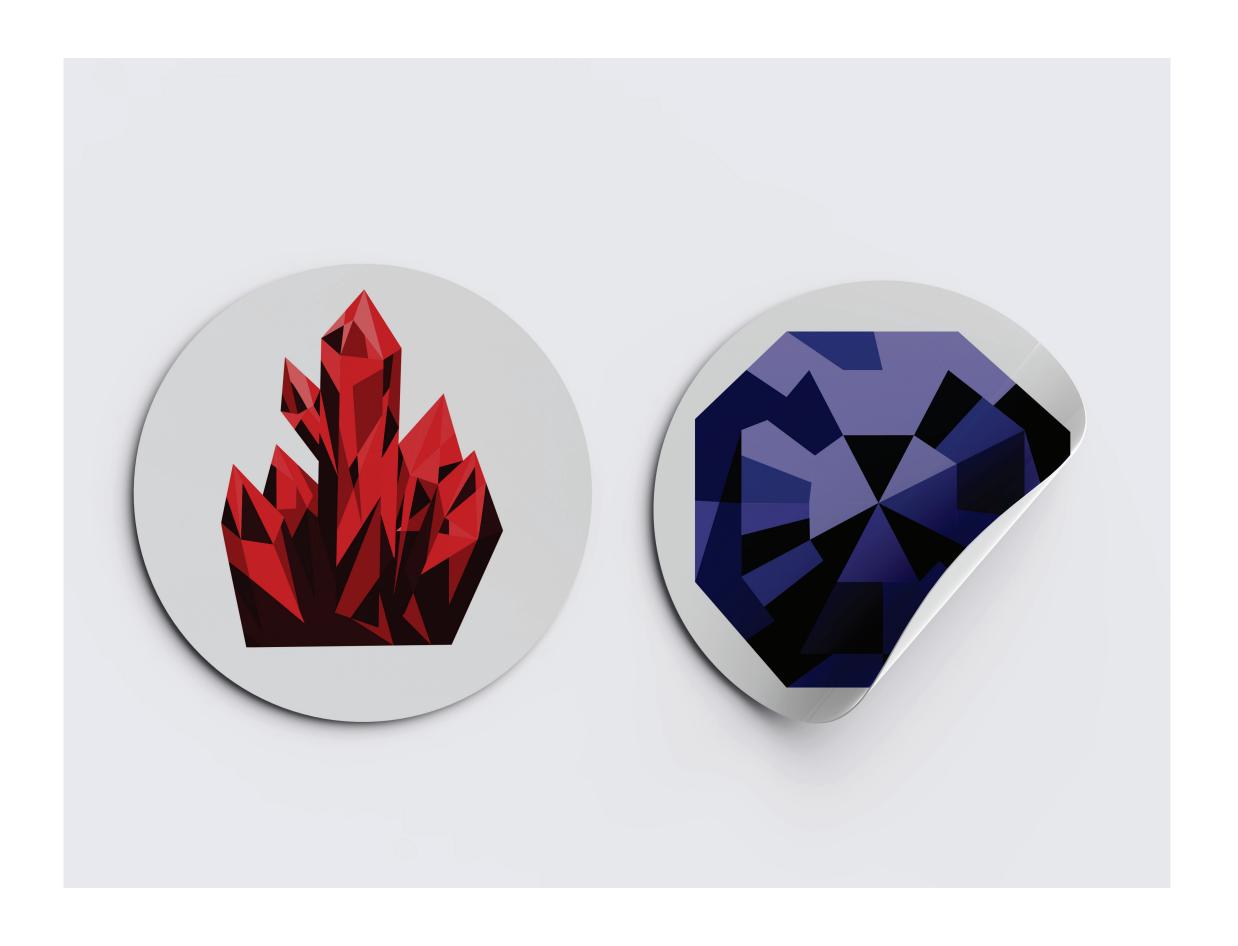
THE SOLUTION:

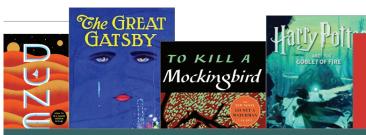

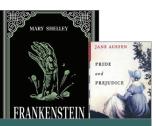
